

How to Apply Fleabusters Rx for Fleas Plus Powder:

When applied properly the powder will rid your home of fleas for a full year. Please read the instructions carefully prior to beginning application.

Important Considerations:

- Dust-sensitive individuals should not be in the room being treated.
- Pets and children should also not be present when treating a room, and as a precaution we recommend the person applying the powder wear a dust mask (available at any home supply store) to avoid inhalation.
- Any powder that does not brush completely into the carpet needs to be vacuumed up immediately.
- If you have a high level of infestation, you may see residual flea activity for 2 to 6 weeks after the application. Vacuuming more frequently will help finish off these stragglers.
- Always remove and discard or empty the vacuum bag immediately after vacuuming.
- If you clean your carpets you will need to reapply this product. If your carpets are due for a cleaning, clean them before you treat them with the powder. Be sure carpet and pad is *completely* dry before applying the product.
- In rooms where there is no carpet, apply the powder to baseboard areas (cracks and crevices).
- Borate is a salt and can cause dry skin if in constant contact with it. Therefore, it is not recommended to treat your pet's bedding unless it is a large, flat *mattress type* pet bed that you can *thoroughly* vacuum and then cover with a thick cover.
- DO NOT use this product on your pet.
- DO Not use the product outdoors to treat lawns or gardens.
- Keep product stored in a cool dry place. It will last unopened or opened for a long time.

Easy Application Instructions:

1. Clear the area you are treating –
Remove all small items (shoes, toys, etc.) from the area, including small items in closets and under beds

2. Remove and Cover -
Relocate your pets and children or others that might be sensitive to the powder out of the room you are treating. Cover all electronic equipment such as computers and VCRs
3. Vacuum-Vacuum -
Vacuum all carpets thoroughly prior to application of the powder. Doing so will improve the effectiveness of the product. Also remove cushions from upholstered furniture and vacuum the wells- (those pockets along the sides and back of the inner frame)
4. Apply Rx for Fleas Plus Powder -
Treat one room at a time. Carefully tilt the container allowing the powder to flow freely. Sprinkle the powder lightly over all carpeted areas, including closet floors and under beds. Don't forget to apply to any area rugs
5. Brush the powder in thoroughly -
Using a push broom, slowly brush the powder into the carpet. It is best to brush in one direction so you evenly distribute the powder. Then using a slow, back and forth sweeping motion, brush into carpet until no visible powder remains. If powder is visible vacuum it up. Fleabusters suggests not resuming regular vacuuming for 48 hours. Avoid lying on the carpet until thoroughly vacuumed
6. Treat furniture -
Remove cushions and sprinkle powder very lightly in the wells only. Work into the wells with a hand brush until powder disappears. Remove any excess powder
7. Bare Flooring
In rooms where there is no carpet, apply the powder to baseboard areas (cracks and crevices). Use a broom to sweep it up under the baseboard or use a powder applicator
